

We've attached a picture of the Nikon Aculon. Unfortunately we haven't tested this laser rangefinder as Nikon has only marketed it as a hunting rangefinder and not for golf. It has gotten great reviews for hunting since it was introduced in 2014. Some negative reviews for golf but some positive too.

When laser or gps rangefinders don't have a standard tripod socket or an integrated belt lip tab, we provide several (a couple for spares) of our belt clip tab/3M adhesive disk assemblies (see attached picture) with the GPS Quick Clip. We've also attached our Leupold laser rangefinder instruction document and pictures. This would be your guide when setting up your Nikon Aculon for use with the Quick Clip. On the attached picture of the Nikon Aculon, we've drawn a white oval where you would stick the belt clip tab/3M adhesive disk assembly to provide the optimal center of gravity.

Having said all of that...the Nikon Aculon looks very similar to the Nikon Cool Shot laser rangefinder that they market for golf. It has a silicone rubber case and our 3M adhesive will not stick to it. Our customers who have a Nikon Cool Shot use a glue to attached the belt clip tab. Unfortunately (though apparently not a big issue to the customers) is the belt clip tab is then permanently attached to their Cool Shot.

So, can you tell us as much as you can about the Nikon Aculon case? Is it made of plastic? Or does it feel like silicone? Try a piece of Scotch tape on it to determine how well it sticks. If it's silicone, the Scotch tape will barely stick. But if the case is plastic, it will stick much better. If we can determine if the belt clip tab can be used with your Aculon, since it weighs 4.5 oz, you would only need our single magnet Quick Clip (\$29.95 including shipping). But if you wanted to spend an extra \$5.00 you could get our heavy duty double magnet Quick Clip.

Remember too...if you buy a Quick Clip and if (for any reason) you don't like the way the Quick Clip works with your rangefinder, we'll refund your \$\$ in full.
